#### EXISTING BUILDINGS

- . IMPROVE OVERALL HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBILITY.
- RESTROOM BUILDING NEEDS IMPROVED SIGNAGE

  AND INTERIOR PENDUATION
- INADEQUATE STORAGE FACILITIES FOR SITE MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT.
- AREAS AROUND THE MANSION HAVE DEVELOPED AN INSTITUTIONAL' FEEL OVER TIME.
   OPPORTUNITY EXISTS TO ENHANCE ENTRANCES AND PLANTINGS TO RESPOND BETTER TO THE ARCHITECTURE AND TRANQUIL PARK SETTING.



#### **EXISTING SPORTS COURTS**

#### **TENNIS COURTS**

- VISUAL SIGNS OF COURT SURFACE CRACKING AND SUBSURFACE FAILURE. COURTS ARE REPORTEDLY CONSTRUCTED ON UNSUITABLE SOILS AND FURTHER MOVEMENT AND CRACKING IS EXPECTED.
- LONG-TERM VIABILITY OF THE COURTS WITHOUT EXTENSIVE SOIL REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT IS QUESTIONABLE.
- · LIGHTING CURRENTLY BEING REPAIRED.
- COURTS ARE POPULAR AND USED REGULARLY. THE PARKS MASTER PLAN SUGGESTS 5 ADDITIONAL TENNIS COURTS.

#### BASKETBALL COURTS

- COURTS ARE CURRENTLY PLACED IN THE CRITICAL FOREGROUND OF THE MANSION.
- COURTS DO GET USED, BUT NOT EXTENSIVELY, ESPECIALLY ALL FOUR.
- · LIGHTS ARE INOPERABLE.
- OPPORTUNITY EXISTS TO RELOCATE COURTS TO AN ACTIVE RECREATION FACILITY (LOCATION TO BE DETERMINED) WITH COMPLIMENTARY USES AND FACILITIES.



#### **EXISTING CIRCULATION PARKING**

- INADEQUATE PARK AND WAYFINDING SIGNAGE. VEHICULAR ACCESS IS CONFUSING THROUGHOUT THE SITE.
- DRIVEWAYS ADJACENT TO PLAYGROUND AND FRONT OF MANSION CREATE POTENTIALLY UNSAFE SITUATIONS.
- PRIMARY PARKING LOT HAS A DEAD-END THAT CAN PROVE CHALLENGING.
- INADEQUATE BACK OF HOUSE SERVICE AREAS.
- PARK IS LIMITED TO ONE VEHICULAR ENTRANCE/ EXIT.
- INADEQUATE PEDESTRIAN ENTRANCES TO THE PARK. NO ACCESSIBLE PEDESTRIAN ENTRANCE.
- OVERALL PEDESTRIAN CIRCULATION PATTERN NEEDS IMPROVEMENT.
- THE "WALK OF TIME" WALKING TRAIL OFFERS A VERY BENEFICIAL WALKING LOOP AND INTERPRETIVE FEATURES.

#### D PLAYGROUND

- NEWER, ENGAGING PLAY EQUIPMENT LOCATED IN NATURALLY SHADED AREA.
- EXISTING UNSAFE CONDITION EXISTS WITH CLOSE PROXIMITY TO NARROW DRIVEWAY.
- OPPORTUNITY EXISTS TO ENHANCE CREATIVE PLAY ELEMENTS AND INCREASE PLAY AREA.

#### E MASTER GARDENER'S DEMONSTRATION GARDENS

- PROVIDES LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PARK VISITORS AND ARE WELL-MAINTAINED.
- NEED EXISTS FOR ADDITIONAL TOOL STORAGE.
- CURRENT DESIGN DOES NOT RELATE WELL TO THE HISTORIC HOME AND PROPERTY.



- SHADED, NATURAL AREA OFFERS OPPORTUNITIES FOR ADDITIONAL CREATIVE PLAY ELEMENTS.
- EXISTING RAIN GARDEN COULD BE ENHANCED TO MITIGATE STORMWATER ISSUES AND ALSO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL INTERPRETIVE OPPORTUNITIES.
- OPPORTUNITY EXISTS FOR ADDITIONAL PICNIC AREAS AND ENHANCEMENTS TO THE PAVILION. 59% OF RESPONDENTS TO PARK MASTER PLAN SURVEY CITED A DESIRE FOR MORE SMALL FAMILY PICNIC AREAS.
- NATIVE WOODLAND GARDEN AREA LACKS APPROPRIATE SCALE AND INTEREST.

#### G NORTHERN WOODED AREA

- AREA LACKS ADEQUATE STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE. GRAVEL WALKING PATH SHOWING SIGNS OF SIGNIFICANT EROSION.
- . SECONDARY TRAIL IS IN POOR CONDITION.
- DENSE PLANTINGS CREATE SAFETY CONCERNS.
- STEEP TOPOGRAPHY AND SIGNIFICANT TREES LIMIT AMOUNT OF GRADING/DEVELOPMENT IN THIS AREA.

#### H PARK ACCESS & PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION


- PARK ACCESS CURRENTLY FUNCTIONS MORE AS A PRIVATE HOME THAN A NEIGHBORHOOD PARK.
- OPPORTUNITY EXISTS TO ENHANCE PARK IDENTITY AT THE STREET, CREATE WELCOMING PEDESTRIAN ENTRANCES, AND ENCOURAGE RESIDENTS TO ACCESS BY FOOT RATHER THAN CAR.



## Q1 Are you a resident of Transylvania County?





## Q2 How many times have you visited Silvermont Park within the last 12 months?







### Q4 What improvement do you feel is most important at the existing park?





## Q5 What feature would you most like to see added?





## Q6 Do you live within walking distance of Silvermont Park?





## Q7 Do you feel safe inside the park?





## Q8 How often do you or a family member play tennis at Silvermont?





## Q9 How often do you or a family member play basketball at Silvermont?




